

### **Southwest Unites to Support Highway 32**

The Southwest region has come together again to partner for improving infrastructure in the Southwest. From improvements to the Swift Current Regional Airport to the repair of Highway 32 the Southwest region is working hard to see positive changes made. Highway 32 is one of a number of highways in the Southwest that is in desperate need of repair and over 20 stakeholders turned out Thursday to show support for discussions to commence on potential avenues to proceed in the highways repair.
